Acceptable Media: All fine art painting or drawing media (oil, pastel, acrylic, watercolor, pencil, charcoal, etc.). Sculpture: Metal, Clay, woodcarving, ceramics, paper Mache', glass art, etc. (Must weight less than 20#. For sculpture pieces smaller



than 10" in diameter, the artist must provide their own display stand with a plexi-glass cover that locks). *Original* Digital art (art created wholly by the artist on his/her computer). Fine Art Photography (industry standards apply) and *Original* Digital photography (art that began as a photograph taken by the artist and altered by the artist). Fabric/Fiber Art (**needlepoint, embroidery, quilts (no larger than 5' on a side) latch-hook, etc.:** original designs only). Fabric/Fiber arts must be in a format suitable to hang on the wall (framed with wire hangers, mounted on wood or other stiff material, or draped on a dowel that can be hung with picture wire). All work must be hung with d-hooks and screws. Wire ends must be taped or sleeved.

- Due to weight requirements, art or photographs over 30" on one side must be framed using plexi-glass not glass.
- Artwork must be signed in with the following information: Your name, address, phone number, title of art and the selling price. Please label your art on the back with the same information.
- The Artist is responsible for picking up art at the end of the show. Storage is not an option. If you can't pick up your own work on the date specified, please make other arrangements to do so.
- Art is hung in the Library at your own risk. The Library and Art-Tique are not responsible for damage or loss of your artwork.

There is no entry fee, but a donation to assist with the cost of printing the catalog and information cards placed with each artwork would be appreciated.
